

End of Course (EOC) Remediation

TEC §39.025 specifies that STAAR EOC assessments be used as the graduation requirement starting with students first enrolled in grade 9 in the 2011 –2012 school year. Regardless of how a student is classified at the end of the year or when he or she is expected to graduate, if the student is first enrolled in grade 9 after the 2011 –2012 school year, then STAAR is his or her graduation requirement. If a student is on an accelerated path toward graduation, it is likely that he or she will have already earned some high school credits for graduation and therefore may have fewer assessments to take to meet graduation requirements. Students in grades 3 –8 who are also enrolled in a high school course will take that STAAR EOC assessment as required for graduation.

SASIC SCHOOL DISTRICT

Are districts required to provide accelerated instruction to students who do not pass the STAAR assessments?

Yes. TEC §39.025(b -1) requires school districts to provide accelerated instruction to each student who fails to perform satisfactorily on an EOC assessment (i.e., who does not achieve Level II: Satisfactory Academic Performance). Likewise, TEC §28.0211(a -1) requires districts to provide accelerated instruction in the applicable subject area each time a student fails to perform satisfactorily (Level II) on an assessment administered in grades 3 –8.

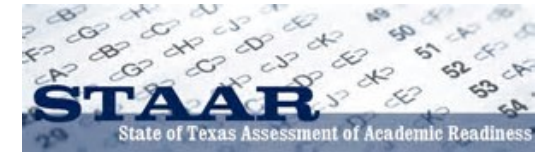
Transportation
